

THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE)
(BRAMLEY LANE, BRAMLEY) ORDER 2011

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council and in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:-

Reason for Order: The Council is satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

Effect of Order: All traffic will be prohibited from travelling along Bramley Road from the junction with Sherfield Road to the junction of Oliver's Lane as directed by traffic signs. The closure is to allow for replacement of water main.

Duration of Order: The order came into effect on 1 August 2011 for 6 months. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected the closure will be for approximately fourteen weeks only)

Alternative Route: From the southern end of closure travel south on Bramley Lane to the C32 Sherfield Road. Turn left and travel eastwards to the A33 Reading Road. Turn left on the A33 and travel northwards to its junction with Welsh Lane. Turn left and travel westwards along Welsh lane and Chequer Lane to Fair Cross. Turn left and travel southwards via New Street, Fair Oak Lane, Stratfield Saye Road and Bramley Lane to the northern end of closure.
