

THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) (B3400 WORTING ROAD, BASINGSTOKE) ORDER 2011

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council has made the following Order:-

Reason for Order: The Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

Effect of Order: All traffic will be prohibited from travelling along Worting Road between the junction with Roman Way and West Ham Lane. The closure is to allow for resurfacing works.

Duration of Order: The order will come into effect on 24 October 2011 for 6 weeks.

Alternative Routes: From the eastern point of the closure travel east on the B3400 Worting Road to its junction with Churchill Way West. Continue straight ahead on the B3400 Churchill Way West to its junction with the A340 Ringway West, turn left. Travel north on Ringway West to its junction with the A339, turn left. Travel west on the A339 to its junction with Roman Road, turn left. Travel south on Roman Road and continue straight ahead into Roman Way. At the junction of Roman Way and the B3400 Worting Road (western point of the closure) turn right or by reverse as indicated by traffic signs.

For traffic from Old Kempshott Lane follow Old Kempshott Lane south to its junction with Lowlands Road and turn left. Travel east on Lowlands Road to its junction with Chiltern Way, turn left. Travel north on Chiltern Way to its junction with the B3400 Worting Road and turn right or by reverse as indicated by traffic signs.
