Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council adopted Landscape and Biodiversity Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 24 June 2008. This adoption statement has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 (Regulation 19). Any person aggrieved by the Landscape and Biodiversity SPD may make an application to the High Court to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event no later than three months after the date when the SPD was adopted.

Subject matter: the purpose of the document is to protect and enhance our borough landscapes and biodiversity by providing guidance on the interpretation of related policies in the Basingstoke and Deane Borough Local Plan 1996-2011).
