

**THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE)  
(SUMMER DOWN LANE, HANNINGTON) ORDER 2011**

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council and in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:-

**Reason for Order:** The Council is satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

**Effect of Order:** All traffic is prohibited from travelling along Summer Down Lane 100 metres north of its junctions with Oakley Road and 100 metres south of its junction with Oakley Road as directed by traffic signs. The closure is to allow to enable replacement of a telegraph pole

**Duration of Order:** The order came into effect on 7 November for 3 months. **(Notwithstanding the above it is expected the closure will be for approximately 11 days only only)**

**Alternative Route:** From the southern end of the closure travel southwards and eastwards to White Lane. Turn left and travel north-eastwards to Ibworth Lane. Turn left and travel westwards to Hannington Village and the northern end of the closure, as indicated by traffic signs and by this route reversed.
