

THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) (NEWBURY ROAD, KINGSCLERE, BASINGSTOKE) NOTICE 2011

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 considers that the closure to the road as specified below should come into force without delay:

Road to be closed:

Newbury Road outside number 19 Newbury Road, Kingsclere, Basingstoke for a distance of 12 metres.

Reason for closure:-

The closure is to allow for the repair of a collapsed sewer. The works are being or are proposed to be executed on the road, to prevent the likelihood of danger to the public. The Council consider it expedient to close the road at this point for the duration of the works.

Period of closure:-

The order will come into effect immediately for a period of 21 days. Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.

Alternative routes:-

Proceed along the A339 Newbury Road, B3051 Ashford Hill Road, George Street and Newbury Road or by this route reversed.
