Top Recycling Tips

- Many people keep two bins in their kitchen - one for recycling, one for rubbish. This makes it easier to separate recycling from rubbish so why not try it yourself?
- Please remember to put all your recycling into your green bin clean, dry and loose. If it is wet, dirty or in plastic bags it cannot be recycled
- Save water! Use your old washing up water to give your tins and plastic bottles a quick rinse before putting them in the green bin
- Flatten all cardboard packaging before putting it in the bin. This will give you plenty of room for all your recycling
- Remember to take the lids off your plastic bottles. This makes them easier to squash. Please put the lids into your rubbish bin as they are often made from a different type of plastic which cannot be recycled
- Every year we throw away 20 billion plastic carrier bags. Get a 'bag for life' which are available from most supermarkets and last for a long time, so you can use them again and again
