

**THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE)  
(SHETLAND ROAD) ORDER 2011**

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council and in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:-

**Reason for Order:** The Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

**Effect of Order:** All traffic will be prohibited from travelling along Shetland Road between its junctions with Faroe Close and Maldive Road as directed by traffic signs. The closure is to allow for realignment, re-surfacing and drainage works.

**Duration of Order:** The order will come into effect on 10 June 2011 for 12 months. **(Notwithstanding the above it is expected the closure will be for approximately nine months)**

**Alternative Route:** Via Carpenters Down and Shetland Road and by this route reversed, as indicated by traffic signs.
