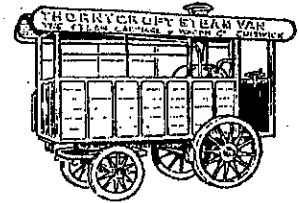

Conditions of Entry:

- Entries must be entered in a clean, complete & safe working condition. Substitute entries only allowed by prior arrangement with organiser.
- All entries must be insured against all third party risks, fully licensed and tested in accordance with the regulations applicable to that type of vehicle for road use. The organisers reserve the right to ask for proof of these items. Entries **MAY NOT BE RUN ON TRADE PLATES.**
- Steam wagons & engines will only be admitted if the owners can show proof of boiler insurance & annual inspection to the Festival Organiser.
- Owners must ensure that all drivers are fully qualified in law to handle the class of vehicle entered. No unlicensed persons to drive on site.
- NO VEHICLES TO BE RUN ON SITE ONCE POSITIONED.** All unattended vehicles shall be left securely braked and/or chocked.
- A speed limit of 10 MPH shall apply to all vehicles, in all event areas off the public highway. No wheel spinning on the grass.
- Drivers must pay full regard to marshals instructions & conduct themselves in a manner which will not inconvenience other road users or other persons at any time.
- Private cars built after the 31st December 1980 will not be accepted unless otherwise negotiated with Section or Rally Organiser.
- There will be no movement of vehicles between 11.00am to 4.00pm under new Health & Safety Regulations.
- Vehicle owners will only be allowed to leave the site in an emergency with rally organisers permission and under supervision of a marshal.
- No petrol generators to be used on site.
