I attended the South West Trains / Network Rail Alliance "Stakeholder Conference" recently and raised the issue of a car park for Whitchurch in the presence of the Managing Director, Tim Shoveller.

I asked Malcolm Page, Station Property Development Manager, two questions:

1. Are you still interested in providing a Station Car Park at Whitchurch?
2. If so, would you be interested in joining a new partnership of bodies to provide it?

Mr Page said that they are still interested but, try as he might, he cannot make the Business Case "stand up" for SWT. He added that they would be interested in working with new partners to provide the car park.

The man in SWT who knows all about the history of failure to obtain highway access for the car park is the Stakeholder Manager, Phil Dominey, and I recommend you to make any initial approach to him.
