Dear Katharine

The Manydown session on 20th October raised a number of concerns about the AECOM Briefing Note and the HCC Technical Note - documents PS/04/56 - which were published on 16th October.

My concerns included:

- the Briefing Note only covered the position to 2021 not 2029
- the Briefing Note was based on a traffic survey undertaken on a single day (9th September) during a period when many people (without school-age children) are on holiday
- the Briefing Note assumed (Annex E1) that 11% of the traffic would leave Area 6a of Manydown via Dorset Crescent even though the draft Inset Map shows only "Pedestrian and cycling links" to Dorset Crescent.

I would like to join the discussion on the further paper (MF23) which is due to be produced by the Council & HCC.

I would also like to participate in any further discussion of papers MF19 (Manydown railway crossing), MF20 (Manydown link road), MF21 (western by-pass) and MF25 (Transport infrastructure in South West).

If these matters are discussed during the morning of 5th November, I would be unable to attend. However, if they are to be considered in the afternoon, I would like to be added to the list of participants.
