Re: Issue 9 Transport (Policy SS11 Whitchurch Station Car Park)

I can attend at 9.30am instead of 2pm on the 5th November, if required. I wait for your final conformation.

Please can I ask you a process question? I am happy with what I have previously sent you in relation to my hearing.

However, since I submitted the information pack two further items have come to my attention. They strengthen my case and I would like to make the Inspector aware. I appreciate there was a closing date for documents, but can I bring them along on the 5th November or make reference to them during the discussions?

The first is an email from Richard Osborn with two attachments. It demonstrates that the planning consultants for the St Cross development had previously written to Network Rail and B&DBC in relation to their proposed car park within the Whitchurch settlement boundary, but have not had any response.

The second is a public document recently produced by the National Trust, which highlights issues where development in the AONB is being passed by local authorities and central government policy is not being applied.

Your guidance would be appreciated.
