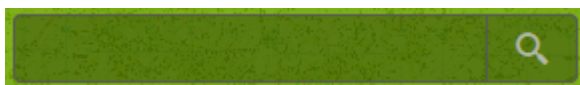
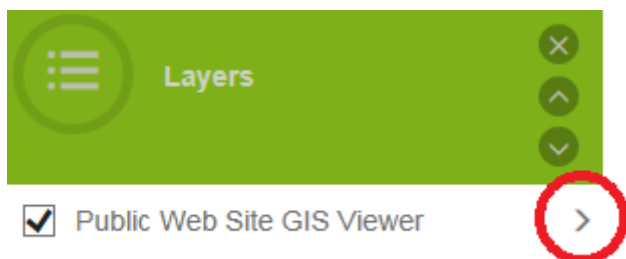


### Instructions for viewing protected trees on the online mapping system

When the map screen opens, to see whether a tree is protected, you can enter your address using the search bar at the top of the page:



You will then need to add the protected tree information. To do this, enlarge the Public Web Site GIS Viewer tab at the top right of the screen by clicking on the > symbol (circled red below):



Then scroll down until you see the 'Tree Preservation Orders TPO' option and ensure that this is checked. Beneath this, there are two further check boxes that will both need to be checked as follows:

- Tree Preservation Orders  
TPO
- TPO Single Trees
- TPO Groups of Trees

To check whether a site is located in a Conservation Area, you will also need to check the 'Conservation Areas' box:

- Conservation Areas
