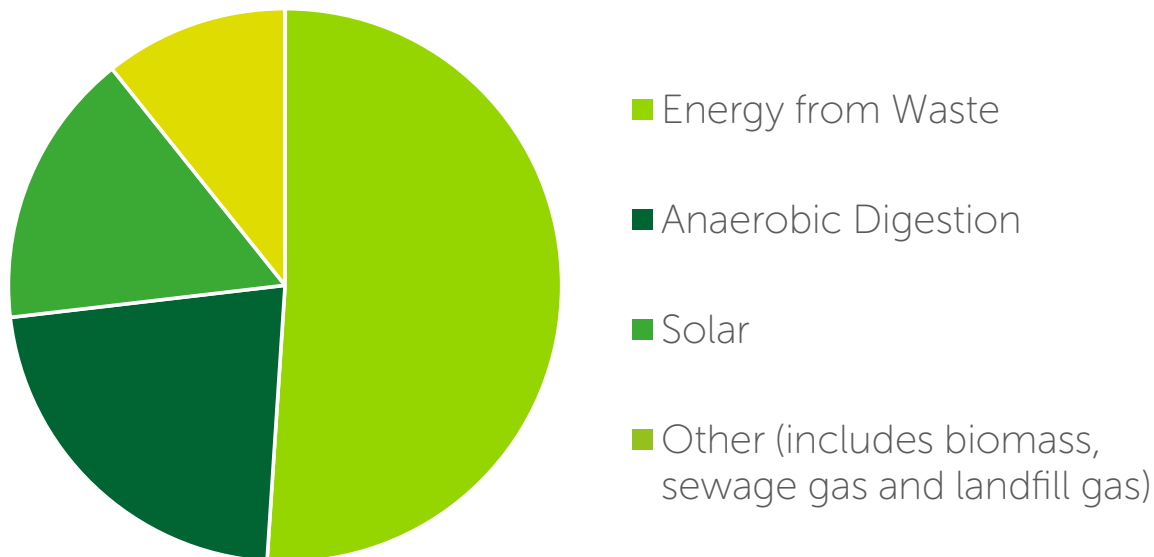

## Total renewable electricity generation in Basingstoke and Deane by technology
