CLEAN AIR ACT 1993 section 4(1)

## Notes

1. If signed as agent, give particulars of principal and capacity in which signed.
2. Address of the building in which the furnace is to be installed. If the furnace is to be installed in a boiler or industrial plant attached to a building, or if the case falls within subsection (6) of section 4, full particulars of the proposal should be given.
3. The following points should be covered in the plans and specifications so submitted:
  - type of furnace;
  - size of boiler combustion rate per square foot of grate and volume of combustion space;
  - method of firing;
  - system for the provision of draught;
  - dimension of flues;
  - method by which dampers are to be operable;
  - particulars of any automatic feed water system to be provided;
  - full particulars of all instruments to be provided for the measurement of heat output and degree of draught; and
  - any recording or indicating CO<sub>2</sub> gas analyser.

Subsection (1) of section 4 of the Clean Air Act 1993 provides that no furnace shall be installed in a building or in any fixed boiler or industrial plant unless notice of the proposal to install it has been given to the local authority.

Subsection (2) of section 4 provides that no furnace shall be installed in a building or in any fixed boiler or industrial plant unless the furnace is so far as practicable capable of being operated continuously without emitting smoke when burning fuel of a type for which the furnace was designed.

Subsection (4) of section 4 provides that any person who installs a furnace in contravention of subsection (1) or (2) or on whose instructions a furnace is so installed shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction;

- (a) in the case of a contravention of subsection (1), to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale; and
- (b) in the case of a contravention of subsection (2), to a fine not exceeding level 5 on that scale.
