"In the Brookvale Community Association, we have much experience in the way in which planning and development occur. Our primary concern is to secure Community Benefit for our Residents when requested infrastructure is not provided. We are very concerned that another 70,000 population in the next 25 years will cost hundreds of millions in infrastructure plus the equivalent amount in services. The villages on both the East and the West of the town will be swallowed up in an urban sprawl. How can we get improved infrastructure and services without mandatory Sustainability Appraisals to include Environmental Impact Assessments?"
