13/03/14	The Old Barn, Rooksdown, not be added to the register of community assets	<p>Further to investigation following the initial nomination, the council has concluded that the Old Barn does not meet the definition of being an asset of community value as set out in the 'Localism Act 2011' Chapter 3, section 88 – Land of community value because:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - although the Grade II listed barn was used as an industrial therapy unit until Park Prewitt Mental Hospital hospital's closure in 1997, the building has not recently been, and is not currently, in use for a social purpose. - the Act excludes the listing of assets which might have a community value in future, since assets are deemed to be of community value only if they have community value presently or in the recent past; 	To list The Old Barn as an Asset of Community Value.
