

CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND POLICE ACT 2001

Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places Order 2005

The Borough Council of Basingstoke and Deane (in this Order called "the Council") hereby make the following Order under Section 13(2) of the said Act:

1. The land described in the Schedule below and shown on the map attached to this Order, being land in the area of the Council which is land to which the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 applies, is hereby designated for the purposes of that Act.
2. This Order may be cited as the Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places (Kingsclere No 1) Order 2005 and shall come into force on the 23rd day of August 2005.

| 11 | Full length of George Street |
| 12 | Full length of Swan Street including The Square |
| 13 | Anchor Yard car park and its approaches from Swan St. & George St. |
| 14 | Entire area of the Recreation Ground |
| 15 | Strokings children's playground |
| 16 | Ashford Hill Road from George Street to junction with Love Lane |
| 17 | Basingstoke Road from George Street to junction with Hook Road |
| 18 | The William Holding Field excluding the premises of the Bowling Club, Youth Club and Tennis Club |
