**Basingstoke and Deane Local Plan 2011-2029
Adoption Statement**

In accordance with the above regulations notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council adopted the Basingstoke and Deane Local Plan 2011-2029 on 26 May 2016.

The Basingstoke and Deane Local Plan 2011-2029 sets out the Council's vision and strategy for the Borough until 2029, the proposed locations for development and policies which will be used in determining planning applications. The Local Plan covers the administrative area of Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council. The Local Plan replaces the 'saved' policies of the Basingstoke and Deane Borough Local Plan Review (1996-2011)

Inspector Mr Mike Fox BA (Hons) DipTP MRTPI, appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, undertook an examination of the Basingstoke and Deane Local Plan 2011-2029 which included public hearing sessions in October and November 2015. The Inspector's report was issued on 6 April 2016 and concluded that the Local Plan is sound and legally compliant subject to the Inspector's main modifications pursuant to Section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

The adopted version of the Basingstoke and Deane Local Plan 2011-2029 incorporates all of the main modifications required by the Inspector.

Hard copies have also been placed on deposit at the borough's libraries.

Any person aggrieved by the Basingstoke and Deane Local Plan 2011-2029 may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the plan is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly, and in any event, no later than 7 July 2016 (6 weeks after the date of adoption specified above).
