Black Dam and Crabtree Plantation provides a wide range of habitats, from mature woodland and wildflower rich downland to chalk stream springs and ancient fishponds.

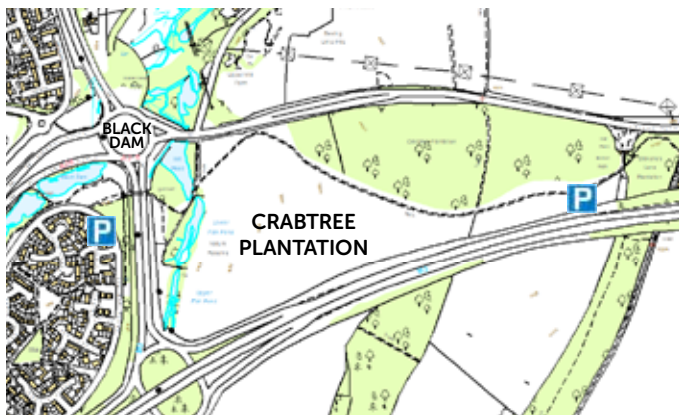
It's a great place for long walks, wildlife watching and even flying kites.
