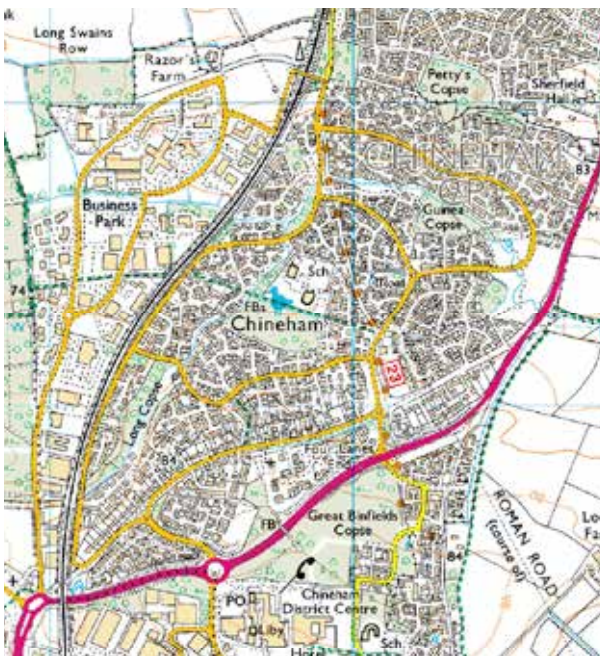
These are all linked by a chalk stream called Petty's Brook which winds its way east through the centre of Chineham towards the River Loddon. This wildlife rich habitat is so important it has been a designated Local Nature Reserve for some years.
