Who are we?

A few local volunteers keen on nature, turning areas of amenity grass into areas rich in wildflowers for butterflies, bees, birds and more. Adjacent to St Marks School we have named them St Marks Meadow and Woodbury Ride. We want residents to join us and learn about our native wildlife.

About the meadow and the ride

The meadow receives lots of sunshine and has been over sown with wildflower seed collected locally. Managed like a traditional meadow the grass will normally be cut once in August and removed. The ride is more sheltered, damp and shady with high trees on both sides, suiting some different plants, insects and birds.

What do we do?

We seed and plant and monitor changes to wildlife and had 11 species of butterfly in the first year. We carry out a little maintenance, share our knowledge and attend courses.
