The Old Hedgerow contains an interesting collection of Elms which are perfect for White-letter Hairstreak butterflies. The Old Orchard has been nurtured back to life and contains a nice mix of orchard trees, wildflowers and hazel coppice.

What do we do?

As our sites are all so different, we get involved in a wealth of conservation tasks. From growing wild flower meadows to dead hedging, hedge laying, coppicing, pathway maintenance and orchard management. It's all go in Kempshott.
