## About the Brookvale green spaces

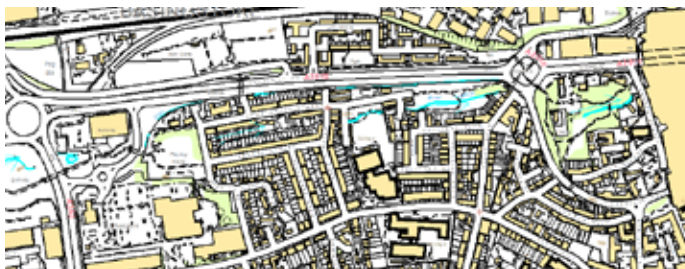
