We are a local group who undertake regular conservation and maintenance work in the Holy Ghost Cemetery, which is also known as South View Cemetery.

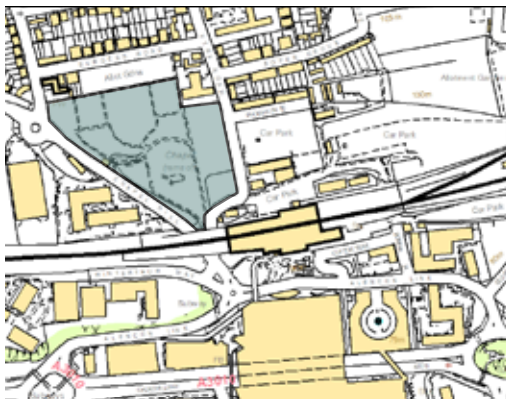
About The Holy Ghost Cemetery

The Holy Ghost Cemetery is a hidden treasure right in the heart of Basingstoke. It was the town's graveyard for 700 years and contains the ruins of two Grade II listed chapels. Several important Basingstoke citizens are buried in the cemetery, including Thomas Burberry and John Aidan Liddell, V.C.

What do we do?

We meet regularly to take on conservation tasks focused on maintaining and increasing biodiversity and the historical integrity of the site. We are also involved in shaping and maintaining The Stationmaster's Garden.
