

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL  
(REVOCATION OF PROHIBITION OF DRIVING ORDER)(OLD BEGGARWOOD LANE, BASINGSTOKE)  
TRAFFIC ORDER 2017**

Notice is hereby given that The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, has made the following Order:

Title:-

This Order may be cited as the Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council  
(Revocation of Prohibition of Driving Order)(Old Beggarwood Lane, Basingstoke) Traffic Order 2017

The effect of the Order will be:-

To revoke in part the Hampshire (Old Beggarwood Lane, Basingstoke)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 2006. The effect of this revocation will be to allow traffic to proceed along Old Beggarwood Lane between the lengths of road detailed in the schedule hereto. This will allow access to the planned new community facility from Broadmere Road.

Date of operation:-

This Order will come into operation on 7th October 2017.

Application to the High Court:-

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections or of Parts I, II, III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 18<sup>th</sup> November 2017 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
