

Kingsclere Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Plan Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)

Adoption Statement

Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council adopted the Kingsclere Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Plan Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on **11 December 2017**. This adoption statement is required by Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004.

Any person aggrieved by the Kingsclere Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Plan SPD may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document. Any such application must be made promptly in any event no later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
