About Popley Ponds

Popley Ponds as it is now known has developed a natural area of trees and plants with seasonal ponds and supports an outstanding range of amphibians, in particular it has a healthy population of Great Crested Newts. The ponds area is now a Local Nature Reserve and the conservation area extends northwards towards Basing Woods with other seasonal water features.

What do we do?

To benefit the newts and other amphibians we have an annual cycle of pond clearing, tree trimming and general area maintenance. We survey newt numbers and the health of the local population
