

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (OAKLAND ROAD AND FIRSWAY, WHITCHURCH)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018**

Notice is hereby given that The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 9 and 10 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, has made the following Order:

Title:-

The title of the Order will be Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Oakland Road and Firsway, Whitchurch) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018

The effect of the Order will be:-

1. To prohibit waiting on those parts of road to which the Order relates, as further detailed in the schedule below.
2. The effect of this order is to make permanent the experimental order entitled Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Oakland Road and Firsway, Whitchurch)(Prohibition of Waiting) Experimental Traffic Regulation Order 2017.

Date of operation:-

This Order will come into operation on 25 August 2018.

Application to the High Court:-

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 9 and 10 or of Parts I, II, III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 6 October 2018 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
