

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND UNLOADING AND PARKING
PLACES (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2018) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2018**

Notice is hereby given that The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, has made the following Order:

Title:-

The title of the Order will be Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Unloading and Parking Places (Consolidation) Order 2018) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2018.

The effect of the Order will be:-

1. To include the provisions of the following Orders within the (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Unloading and Parking Places (Consolidation) Order 2018:
 - a) Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Packenham Road, Basingstoke) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Order 2018 and
 - b) Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Various Roads) (No.2) Order 2017
2. Updating the plans annexed to the Consolidation Order to reflect current restrictions.
3. With regard to items 1 and 2 above, there are no changes to current restrictions and the proposal is simply to consolidate orders for ease of reference.
4. To update parking charges and charging hours for Joices Yard Car Park as shown in Schedule 1 below
5. To update charges for permit parking schemes as shown in Schedule 2 below.

Date of operation:-

This Order will come into operation on 13 October 2018.

Application to the High Court:-

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 124 or of Parts I, II, III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 24 November 2018 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
