

**THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL
(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) (A30 WINCHESTER ROAD, HATCH
WARREN (HOUNSOME FIELDS)) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council and in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, proposes to make the following Order:-

Reason for Order: The Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted or prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to such works.

Effect of Order: All traffic will be prohibited from:

(1) Turning left or right from Hounsome construction access road to link road to A30 Winchester Road southbound carriageway by following the Ahead Only signs;

(2) Turning right from the A30 Winchester Road southbound carriageway onto the link road;

(3) Turning left from the link road onto A30 Winchester Road southbound carriageway, as directed by traffic signs. The closure is for a temporary construction access for development.

Duration of Order: The order will come into effect on 01 April 2019 for 18 months. **(Notwithstanding the above it is expected the closure will be 18 months)**

Alternative Route: no diversion route in place.
