

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND UNLOADING AND PARKING
PLACES (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2018 (AMENDMENT NO.3)(TOWN WARD SCHOOLS) ORDER

Notice is hereby given that The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, has made the following Order:

Title:-

The title of the Order will be Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Unloading and Parking Places (Consolidation) Order 2018) (Amendment No. 3)(Town Ward Schools) Order 2018.

The effect of the Order will be:-

To introduce the following parking controls:

- **Chiltern Way (Plans AU56, AU57) Chiltern School area** - School Keep Clear marking and prohibition of loading/unloading.
- **Neville Close (Plans BA58, BA59) Queen Marys College area** - Double and single yellow lines.
- **Kingsmill Road (Plan AZ60) St Johns School area** - Extension of double yellow lines and new single yellow line.
- **Danebury Road (Plan AU67) Hatch Warren School area** - Extension of single yellow line.
- **Upper Sherborne Road, Sherborne Road, Oakridge Road (Plans AZ49, AZ50) Oakridge Schools area** – Changes and extensions to existing double yellow lines and new double yellow lines.
- **Shetland Road (Plans BB45, BB46) Marnel Schools area** - Double yellow lines and existing school keep clear marking.

as further detailed in the plans specified in Schedule 2 and attached to the Order.

Date of operation:-

This Order will come into operation on 13 April 2019.

Application to the High Court:-

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections or of Parts I, II, III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 25 May 2019 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
