In 2010, residents came forward to develop a community plan for the South Ham Ward. After three years of hard work and talking to residents, the plan was published in 2013 and then reviewed in 2014. The South Ham Network, the group that has been championing the plan, has been updating the action plan and feeding back all the great work and new initiatives that have been developed using evidence gained from the questionnaires completed over the years.

Promote the use of public spaces and reduce dog fouling and litter

- Green Week workshops
- Willow weaving workshops
- National Play Day activities at Russell Howard Park
- CSPO dog fouling campaign
- Community litter picks
- New bins and a new grit bin at Russell Howard Park and Westside Community Centre
- Gained funding to create the community garden at Westside Community Centre and the Garden of Light at St Joseph's Church

Adult education and employment

- IT skills workshops and courses
- One-to-one careers advice
- Family hub drop-in including benefits/debt advice and accredited training

Activities for older people

- £150,000 funding for Howard Park Bowl Club
- Seated Pilates at Westside Community Centre
- Various new activities at St Peter's Church
- Funding to start a community choir
- Produced leaflet to promote over 55s activities in the area

Enhance youth activities

- Westside Community Centre employed a 0 to 19 officer to co-ordinate and deliver services including a health hub and youth club
- Developed a brochure to promote children, young people and families' services in the area
