

THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) (BINLEY BOTTOM, ST MARYBOURNE) ORDER 2019

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council and in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, proposes to make the following Order:-

Reason for Order: The Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

Effect of Order: All traffic will be prohibited from travelling along Binley Bottom, from the junction with Lye Farm Road to the entrance to Highfield Farm, as directed by traffic signs. The closure is to allow for Openreach duct box repairs.

Duration of Order: The order will come into effect on 21 October 2019 for 1 month. **(Notwithstanding the above it is expected the closure will be for 5 days between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30)**

Alternative Route: Binley Bottom, Crux Easton Lane, New Barn Lane, Harrow Way, Stoke Lane, Baptist Hill, Wadwick Bottom, Red Lane and vice versa.
