

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND UNLOADING AND PARKING
PLACES (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2018 (AMENDMENT NO.14)(VARIOUS PARISHES,
BASINGSTOKE) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 122 (1) and (2), 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, proposes to make the following Order:

Title:-

The title of the Order, if made, will be Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Unloading and Parking Places (Consolidation) Order 2018) (Amendment No. 14)(Various Parishes, Basingstoke) Order 2019.

The effect of the Order will be:-

To impose the following restrictions on parts of the below roads as more particularly defined in the plans attached to the draft Order:

- Crockford Lane, Chineham – No waiting at any time
- Reading Road, Chineham – No waiting at any time
- Sprents Lane, Overton – Removal of disabled parking bay and reinstatement of limited waiting/permit holders only parking
- Herriard Way/New Road, Tadley – No waiting at any time
- Park Prewett Road/Pumphouse Way, Rooksdown – No waiting at any time
- The Street and Ringshall Gardens, Bramley – No waiting at any time
- Tot Hill overbridge/services roundabout, Burghclere – No waiting at any time
- Test Road, Whitchurch – No waiting at any time
