As part of my examination, I am able to seek clarification on matters and ask for documents in the public domain that may assist my examination.

Please can the Parish Council provide me with copies of representations made at the Regulation 14 stage from developers/landowners/agents for the allocated sites and other sites promoted for residential development.

In response to Historic England's Regulation 14 comments, the Parish Council has stated that full Historic Environment Records were commissioned and that the maps confirm all sites selected for evaluation have no areas of archaeological interest. (page 49 in the Consultation Statement). Please can the Parish Council provide me with copies of these maps. I am happy for these maps to be attached to an email.

I understand from the representations that there is a joint acoustics report for the Stokins Road and Coppice Road sites that has previously been submitted to the Parish Council. Is this the Report on the Parish Council's web page - Noise Assessment June 2014? If not, please can I have a copy.

Please can this email, together with the documents requested, be placed on the Neighbourhood Plan web page.
