

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL
(PART OF FOOTPATH 701)
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2020**

On the 22 April 2021, Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council confirmed the above order as an unopposed order made under s118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed will extinguish the public footpath running from SU 6075 4844 to SU 6083 4814 as shown on the order plan.

Due to the Coronavirus epidemic we are unable to place the documents on deposit at the reception of the Civic Offices.

This order comes into force immediately, but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is first published, make an application to the High Court.

It should be noted that the purpose of this order is to extinguish the part of Footpath 701 which crosses over several properties in Heritage Park which were built several years ago. The footpath has no further purpose and there are sufficient local footpaths to provide linkage between the points of closure of the footpath.
