

**THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2021**

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council and in exercise of the powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and Sections 63 and 64 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 (“the Act of 1976”) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, has made the following Order:-

**Title:-** The Order may be cited as The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2021 (“the Order”).

**The effect of the Order will be:-**

1. To revoke the current 2018 Consolidation Order and all orders which sought to amend the Consolidation order made after 14 April 2018 imposing the following restrictions:
  - (a) Prohibitions and restrictions of waiting, loading and unloading;
  - (b) Prohibitions of stopping,
  - (c) Loading areas,
  - (d) Restrictions on parking places (including disabled parking places, motor cycle parking places, taxi ranks and permit parking)
 as they relate to roads in the Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council area as defined in the Order.
2. To revoke the Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Electric Vehicle Charging Places)(Feathers Yard, Basingstoke) Order 2020, Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Electric Vehicle Charging Places)(Clifton Terrace, Basingstoke) Order 2021, Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Various Roads)(No.2) Order 2017, Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Packenham Road, Basingstoke)(Prohibition of Driving) Traffic Order 2018, Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Schroeder Close) Traffic Order 2018, Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Oakland Road and Firsway, Whitchurch) (Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 and Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition of Waiting and no Stopping) (Park Prewett Road and Area, Rooksdown) Traffic Order 2018.
3. To re-enact the above restrictions in a new consolidated order for clarity.
4. To update clauses within the Consolidation Order to include provision for Electric Vehicle charging points.
5. To re-enact the current permit parking and on-street parking places charges as shown below (which remain unchanged):

This Order will come into operation on 7 August 2021.

**Application to the High Court:-**

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections or of Parts I, II, III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 18 September 2021 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
