

THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) (SOKE ROAD, MORTIMER WEST END) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council and in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers has made the following Order:-

Reason for Order: The Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

Effect of Order: All traffic will be prohibited from travelling along Soke Road, as directed by traffic signs. The closure is to enable tree management on the power lines and 20m either side of the road.

Duration of Order: The order will come into effect on 24 August 2021 for 3 months. **(Notwithstanding the above it is expected the closure will be 1 day only during this period between the hours of 08:30 - 16:00)**

Alternative Route: Reading Road, A340, Silchester Road, Pamber Road, Soke Road or by this route reversed.
