

THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) (VYNE ROAD & CHAPEL HILL, BASINGSTOKE) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council and in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers has made the following Order:-

Reason for Order: The Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

Effect of Order: All traffic will be prohibited from travelling along Vyne Road & Chapel Hill, Basingstoke, from roundabout on Chapel Hill (near the bridge) to:

- 1) the roundabout near the cemetery on Chapel Hill
- 2) the station car park entrance on Vyne Road, as directed by traffic signs. The closure is to allow for steel repairs to the rail bridge running over Vyne Road and Chapel Hill.

Duration of Order: The order will come into effect on 26 September 2021 for 3 months. **(Notwithstanding the above it is expected the closure will be for two 27 hour periods to coincide with works on the railway lines during the 3 month period)**

Alternative Route: Alencon Link, Churchill Way West, Ringway West, Brunel Road, Houndsmill Road, Kingsclere Road, Burgess Road, Vyne Road or by this route reversed.
