Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council adopted the Laverstoke and Freefolk Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Plan Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 14th December 2021. The SPD provides detail to expand upon the policies in the Basingstoke and Deane Borough Local Plan (2011-29).

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Supplementary Planning Document may make an application to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly in any event no later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
