

THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY 30MPH SPEED RESTRICTION) (A30 WINCHESTER ROAD, BASINGSTOKE) ORDER 2022

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council and in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:-

Reason for Order: The Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

Effect of Order: All traffic will be subject to a 30mph speed restriction along A30 Winchester Road, Basingstoke on both lanes, from Saunders Way Rdbt to 265m south west of new roundabout, as directed by traffic signs. The 30mph speed restriction is to enable works to be carried out safely during construction of development access.

Duration of Order: The order will come into effect on 18 April 2022 for 1 year. **(Notwithstanding the above it is expected the 30mph speed restriction is likely to be for 7 months only during this period)**

Alternative Route: N/A.

The exemptions under S 87 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 will apply to the Order.
