Basingstoke & District Disability Forum (BDDF)	New temporary 'Volunteer Advocate Coordinator' to set up and launch a Community Advocate programme to engage individuals to volunteer from the Disabled community to support BDDF and increase capacity.	£10,000.00
Lordsfield Swimming Club (Overton)	Specialist project manager to ensure delivery of their refurbishment project for their swimming pool to ensure the project can go ahead to provide continued long-term availability to the local community and income.	£10,000.00
ArtWell	Additional staff capacity for research and development of a program of chargeable workshops to increase income, review of management and data systems and promotional materials.	£10,000.00
Fluid Motion Theatre Company	Additional staff capacity to enhance the use of digital technology and data analysis to improve the ability to seek additional support, including corporate sponsors and to strengthen partnerships and the team.	£9,845.00
St. Michael's Hospice	Consultant to develop a fundraising project plan tailored to their specific requirements and identify and implement improvements to the fundraising system; training for the fundraising team to maximise system use.	£6,202.00
Westside Community Association	Purchase of computers and a printer/photocopier to extend capacity of the library space and pantry and for use by the local community to help improve access to local services and skills development.	£4,365.00
Free Legal Advice Group for Domestic Violence (FLAG DV)	Extra staff capacity to recruit additional pro-bono solicitors and to update the case management system in order to support increased demand from the Basingstoke and Deane area.	£9,525.00
Community Furniture Project	External support with marketing, fundraising and business development, as well as staff and volunteer skills development to increase the range of items that can be repaired and refurbished within their operations.	£9,954.50
Old Basing Village Hall	Part of a transformation programme to create a modern booking system and improve fundraising capabilities to allow them to improve revenues and better target new revenue streams and fundraising opportunities.	£3,238.00
Home-Start North West Hampshire	Initiate a paid role, with a view to it becoming self-funding, with the intention of developing a long-term sustainable funding pipeline through corporate partnerships, sponsors, and events.	£10,000.00
Silchester Village Hall	New website; booking and reservation system for the hall, and work on a trio of plans (Strategic Business plan, marketing plan, and a utilisation plan for the premises) designed to revitalise and repopulate the hall.	£10,000.00
Basingstoke & District Young Carers	Staff member responsible for marketing, business development and growth strategy on a 6-month contract, produce a promotional video, and enhance the BDYC App.	£9,600.00
Oakley Bowling Club	Specialised sports lawnmower and its associated accessories (50% of the total cost with the remainder covered from reserves), to maintain the green to regional and national tournament standards.	£4,689.00
Basingstoke Mencap	Extra people/hours to increase weekly open days for the Greenfingers project from 3 to 5, increased capacity and to extend the garden maintenance service to support more people with learning disabilities.	£9,950.00
