

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL  
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING  
PLACES (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2021 (AMENDMENT NO.1)(DISABLED  
PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2021**

Notice is hereby given that The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 122 (1) and (2), 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, has made the following Order:

**Title:-**

The title of the Order will be Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places (Consolidation) Order 2021 (Amendment No.1)(Disabled Parking Places) Order 2021

**The effect of the Order will be to:**

Introduce disabled persons' parking bays for disabled residents who require convenient parking. To amend existing resident permit bays in Sprents Lane, Penrith Road and Coronation Road, and to remove unused disabled persons' parking bays. The amendments include:

1. Removal of disabled parking bays in:  
Challoner Close, Rossini Close, Wagner Close, Holst Close, Firth Close, Knight Street, Montserrat Road and Cavalier Close; and
2. Introduction of new disabled parking bays in:  
Sprents Close, Pinkerton Road, Margaret Road, Verdi Close, Bliss Close, Fairfields Road, Franklin Avenue, Holst Close, Montserrat Road, Trinidad Close, Coleman Close, Penrith Road, Coronation Road, Oakfields Close, Gainsborough Road and Rucstall Centre

**Date of Operation:-**

This Order will come into operation on 10 September 2022.

**Application to the High Court:-**

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 122 (1) and (2), 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections or of Parts I, II, III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 22 October 2022 make application for the purpose to the High Court
