

**THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE)
(BRAMLEY RAIL CROSSING) ORDER 2022**

Notice is hereby given that Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council and in exercise of the powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, proposes to make the following Order:-

Reason for Order: The Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

Effect of Order: All traffic will be prohibited from travelling along Bramley Rail Crossing, 20m either side of crossing, as directed by traffic signs. The closure is to allow access and egress of RRV and delivery of materials.

Duration of Order: The order will come into effect on 08 October 2022 for 1 Year. **(Notwithstanding the above it is expected the closure will be over 3 separate nights on (8/10/22 from 23.30 - 04.00) (18/2/23 from 23.30 - 08.00) (07/04/23 from 01.00 - 08.00) during this period**

Alternative Route: Sherfield Road, A33, Ringway North, A340, Bramley Road, Boars Bridge or this route reversed.
