Once agricultural land, this site is now a haven for wildlife. It has such a rich variety of flora and fauna that it has been a Local Nature Reserve for some years now. It has a wide range of habitats from stream and water meadow to woodland and is a great place for wildlife throughout the year. Stars of the show include Bee Orchids, Little Egret, Grasshopper Warblers and Roe Deer.

What do we do?

In the summer we run guided walks and community events, including moth nights. During the winter months we tackle the ever growing scrub in order to maximise the areas of grassland, installing boardwalks and laying chips for the muddy areas.
