

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2019
(AMENDMENT NO 4)(BELL STREET CAR PARK, WHITCHURCH) ORDER 2022**

Notice is hereby given that The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, has made the following Order:

Title:-

The title of the Order will be the Basingstoke and Deane (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (Amendment No 4)(Bell Street Car Park, Whitchurch) Order 2022.

The effect of the Order will be:-

To introduce car parking charges for Bell Street Car Park, Whitchurch, including the provision of resident permit parking and business permit parking within the car park. Business permits will be available for vehicles associated with a commercial address in Whitchurch. Resident's permits will be available for vehicles associated with a residential address in Whitchurch. Resident's permits will be limited to 1 per household and may be declined from households with off-street parking.

The Council has previously consulted on this Order and having considered comments received, it has been decided to make the order with modification. The modification will be to allow for the first hour of the parking period to be free of charge. The charges for parking and permits can be seen in the below schedule.

Date of operation:-

This Order will come into operation on 1 April 2023.

Application to the High Court:-

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections or of Parts I, II, III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 6 May 2023 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
