

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2021 (AMENDMENT NO.12) (CIVIC OFFICES, LEISURE PARK, LODDON MALL COURTYARD AND DOWN GRANGE) ORDER 2023**

**Statement of Reasons**

The existing parking controls in the Civic Offices, Leisure Park, Loddon Mall Courtyard and Down Grange Car Parks are currently included in the Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places)(Consolidation) Order 2021, an on-street order. As of 31 March 2023, Basingstoke Council will no longer have an agency agreement with Hampshire County Council to enforce on-street parking, it is therefore proposed to include the Civic Offices, Leisure Park, Loddon Mall Courtyard and Down Grange Car Parks in the 2019 off street order so Basingstoke Council can continue to enforce these areas.

The Civic Offices, Leisure Park, Loddon Mall Courtyard and Down Grange Car Parks will therefore be revoked from the Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places)(Consolidation) Order 2021 and inserted into the Basingstoke and Deane (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2019.

Therefore, having consulted the Chief Officer of Police, it has been considered to exercise the functions conferred on the council by S122(1) and having regard for S122 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as this course of action will secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of vehicular traffic and other traffic (including pedestrians).
