

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2019
(AMENDMENT NO 2)(EASTROP CAR PARKS) ORDER 2021**

Notice is hereby given that The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and regulation 14 (3) and (4) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedures)(England and Wales) Regulations 1996, has made the following Order:

Title:-

The title of the Order, will be the Basingstoke and Deane (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (Amendment No 2)(Eastrop Car Parks) Order 2021

The effect of the Order will be:-

To introduce car parking charges at Eastrop Park car parks in order to support the management, maintenance and improvement of the car park and better manage use of the car parks. The proposals will encourage non-park users to park elsewhere, freeing up space for park users. The proposal will also encourage cycling and walking which is in support of Council's climate change emergency actions. The Order will secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic and the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities off the highway. The tariff can be seen in the below schedule.

Date of operation:-

This Order will come into operation on 7 May 2022.

Application to the High Court:-

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of those Sections or of Parts I, II, III or IV of Schedule 9 to the Act or any requirements made under the said Part III of Schedule 9 have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by 18 June 2022 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
