

**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2019 (AMENDMENT NO 9)
(EASTLANDS CAR PARK) ORDER 2023**

Notice is hereby given that The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 5, 32, 35 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, proposes to make the following Order:

Title:-

The title of the Order, if made, will be the Basingstoke and Deane (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2019 (Amendment No 9) (Eastlands Car Park) Order 2023.

The effect of the Order will be:-

1. To include Electric Vehicle charging bays on the forecourt at Eastlands Car Park to be used by Council permit holders only Monday to Friday 8:00 to 19:00 and for general public use at all other times including Saturday and Sunday.
2. To formalise pay and display provisions which currently exist at Eastlands Car Park to include Sunday.
