**BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL, ST MARY BOURNE FOOTPATH
37, PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2026**

On 23 April 2026 Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council confirmed the above order without modification.

The above order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath running from point A to point B to point Z (from SU 42081 50419 to point SU 42112 50391 to point SU 42103 50348) and creates an alternative footpath as shown on the order map. The footpath diverted is located at St Mary Bourne Village Centre, Bourne Meadow, St Mary Bourne.

A copy of the confirmed order and order map may be seen free of charge at Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council, Civic Offices, London Road, Basingstoke, Hampshire between the hours of 8.30am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday. Copies of the order and the order map can be bought there at the price of £2.50. The order comes into force on 1 May 2026 but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
